2022 TURLEY “KIRSCHENMANN VINEYARD” ZINFANDEL LODI

HISTORY

The Kirschenmann Vineyard is close to our hearts as our winemaker, Tegan Passalacqua, owns and farms this vineyard. The ungrafted vines were planted in 1915 in the silica-rich sandy soils of the east side of the Mokelumne River AVA. Thanks to the river’s cool waters and delta breezes, these head-trained, dry-farmed vines are constantly protected from the heat. In the grand tradition of old-vine field blends, the vineyard has small amounts of Mondeuse, Cinsault, and Carignane.

TASTING NOTES

Organically farmed, own-rooted, head-trained and dry-farmed vines planted in 1915 in the silica-rich sandy soils of the east side of the Mokelumne River AVA. A beguiling nose that pulls you in, this wine is the essence of old vine Zinfandel. A layered wine of mouthwatering red fruits, roasted meats, sandalwood, and dust.

Varieties: Zinfandel, Mondeuse Noir, Cinsault, Carignane

Viticulture: Head-trained, own-rooted, dry-farmed, hand harvested

Barrels: 80% used oak, 20% new 80% French oak, 20% American

Aging: 15 months in barrel

Bottled unfinned and unfiltered

Alcohol: 15.6%
